Limit 500 runs per judge per day - with no more than 350 runs with jumps.

Notice to Exhibitors

Exhibitors, through submission of entry you acknowledge that you have read NADAC Rules & Regulations as presented on www.nadac.com including but not limited to:

- This test is open to all dogs of at least 18 months of age, including mixed breeds.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- Safety must always be of primary consideration in your actions and conduct. You alone are responsible for the behavior of your dogs and children. If your dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, the show committee can ask you to leave the show site. In such case, we will not refund any fees.
- **Dogs must be registered with NADAC – no pending numbers will be accepted.**
- All dogs, Novice, Open and Elite jumping 16" or less (except Veterans/Skilled Division dogs jumping 16) **MUST** be measured unless they present a permanent height card at check-in or have sent a copy to the trial secretary along with their entry
- No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring at any time.
- The Show Committee can refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through NADAC rules and regulations. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC cannot enter the trial.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Running order will be determined at the clubs discretion. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated.
- Check-in and Start Times – we will e-mail confirmations prior to the trial; these will include check-in and start times and running order information. (subject to changes)
- Refunds –After the closing date, NO entry fees will be refunded for dogs pulled from the trial - except for bitches that come into season before Thursday of the trial week in which case 50% of the entry fees paid will be returned.
- **Move-ups – we will accept move-ups until December 29th, 2008 at 6PM.** If you title on Saturday/Sunday we will accept your move-up request if it is submitted within 15 minutes of the end of the last class each day.

Location and Directions

WAG, Inc. 10925 Bruceville Road, Elk Grove, California

One ring – covered arena – dirt surface

From Hwy 5 North or South

Take the Elk Grove Blvd exit & go East. Go approx. 3 miles to Bruceville Rd & turn Right. Go approx 3.5 miles. Turn left in driveway at 10925 Bruceville Rd. WAG sign at driveway.

From Hwy 99 North or South

Take the Elk Grove Blvd exit & go West. Go approx 1 mile to Bruceville Rd & turn Left. Go Approx 3.5 miles. Turn left in driveway at 10925 Bruceville Rd. WAG sign at driveway.

Overnight Camping

Categories

A dog may only be entered in ONE category per weekend.

Proficient Category	Skilled Category
Work towards a NATCH (plaque)	Work toward Medal
A qualifying round must be clean and will earn 10 points.	In the Regular agility class, dogs entered in the Skilled Category may incur 5 or fewer faults, and earn a 5 point qualifying round.
Jumping at Proficient jump height for standard, veterans, or JH division	As of January 1, 2009, when entering the Skilled Category, all dogs must take a 4" jump height reduction from their Proficient, Standard Division jump height. <i>SCT of lower jump height is used. For instance, a 20" dog jumping 16" would get the 16" time.</i>

Divisions (offered in each category)

- Standard
- Veterans for dog or handler
- Jr. Handler
- Veteran/Disabled handler: *Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler. Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.*

Classes

The following are offered in each category and for each level and division:

- Regular
- Jumpers
- Chances

The following classes are offered in each category for each level and the standard and veteran handler divisions:

- Tunnelers
- Weavers
- Touch and Go
- Hoopers

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoo.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represent that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor / Owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor / Owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current on accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor / Owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people, exhibitor and owner assume the risk of a harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor / Owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), & Haute Dawgs Agility Group and (WAG) Western Agility Group, Inc. (including its officers, directors, and members and event organizing committee) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor / owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time inconsequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. After the closing date, NO entry fees will be refunded for dogs pulled from the trial - except for bitches that come into season between Tuesday-Thursday in which case 50% of the entry fees paid will be returned.
